

BOOK REPORT for RHVA General Meeting on 16 September 2023

Cash in bank is \$15,177.05 plus \$533 remaining from AusPost grant. Still need to pay \$600 for stickers.

Rescue station boxes have been installed at Sth Inyadda beach and Washerwoman's Beach. We now have 24/7 defibs at Cunjurong Shop, Fire Shed, Hall, Sth Inyadda, Bendalong Real Estate, Washerwoman's.

Next installations will be Bendalong Boat Ramp and the middle of Manyana Beach. Boat Ramp will have the new CellaED defibrillator. (displayed)

I'd like to acknowledge the generosity of 10 families who have homes here and who regularly visit. Their anonymous donations totalled \$8,000 which covered the cost of 2 rescue stations and part of another one. Each station with the large defib costs \$3,600.

Feedback suggests further possible three locations as 1. Nth Manyana, 2. close to Conjola Lake entrance/Green Island beach and 3. Nth Inyadda Bendalong beach.

Our committee of 6 welcomed another member - Michael Shaw who monitors and records data for the Washerwoman's station.
