Exciting news! As you are aware, Shoalhaven City Council is currently preparing a [Coastal Management Program](#) (CMP) to help manage and protect the Lake Conjola estuary. The project has recently completed Stage 2 which involved identifying key risks, vulnerabilities and opportunities for the long-term management of Lake Conjola.

The CMP has now entered **Stage 3** which involves identifying and evaluating opportunities to address coastal risks consistent with management objectives. This Stage incorporates the findings of the technical studies and community and agency feedback already gathered through consultation held in April 2022. As part of Stage 3, Council needs your input on the proposed management actions that have been developed. Your feedback will help shape the CMP and ensure community support, feedback and suggestions are captured.

You can provide your feedback online by reviewing the [proposed management actions](#) that will be applied across the Lake Conjola CMP and completing the [online survey](#). Several potential management actions can also be viewed on a map as they are location specific. You can show your support for the mapped actions using the interactive [Map-based Feedback Portal](#). The interactive [Map-based Suggestion Portal](#) can be used to provide additional suggestions for potential management actions that will be reviewed by the project team.
