

REPORT FROM THE YULUNGA RESERVE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE 23 March,2024

The Yulunga Reserve is council property. It is maintained by the Yulunga Reserve Management Committee, a group of local volunteers who give their time to look after the hall, the tennis courts, the oval, the skate and basketball park and the children's playground.

Latest news from the committee

Six bangalay gums have been planted on both sides of the oval and at the eastern end as part of council's policy of planting 2 for every one tree removed. Bangalay gums had to be removed beside the council toilet block beside the hall. These trees were removed to enable the Five Villages' Community Garden to be constructed. The trees were in poor condition but were also impacting the council building with invasive roots lifting the concrete slab.

The eastern end of the oval area has been cleared of dying wattle and weeds. The area will be mown and appropriate tree plantings will continue.

The area just outside the community garden has been regenerated with native plantings and the verge garden on The Palisade is growing well, softening the fence line.

The mural painted by the artist known as Trait on the wall on the basketball court has been well received by the community and has brightened up an otherwise dull wall. He generously donated his time and materials and completed the work in 3 days.
