RESERVE MANAGEMENT

The area at the eastern end of the oval continues to be cleared and new plantings of trees made. The street verge area in front of the Five Villages' Community Garden continues to be developed with new plantings of native shrubs.

THE HALL EXTENSION PROJECT

This topic is on the agenda for general business but there are two points that need clarification.

1. Accommodating the needs of the permanent users of the hall. Council and the committee have worked with the Central Shoalhaven Central Mobile Pre School (CSMP) to find an alternative venue for when works begin. With no local option, the Lake Conjola Community Hall has been organised to be hired. The pre-school will definitely see out this term in the hall. The Combined Pensioners Association will use the soccer shed and council negotiations are underway for the yoga sessions to maybe held in the recreation room at Holiday Haven Bendalong. The Manyana Markets will also be able to be held on the October long weekend.
2. Council elections-The management committee was asked by the Electoral Commission in March if the hall would be available for the council elections in September. At that time, it looked highly unlikely that the hall would be, so it was not hired by the Electoral Commission. Unfortunately, the slow progress of the DA and subsequent ongoing discussions with council meant the hall could have been a polling booth last weekend. It was an unfortunate set of circumstances and the management committee apologises for the inconvenience caused to the residents of the five villages.
