

## **REPORT FROM YULUNGA RESERVE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE TO RHVA 19.04.2025**

### **RETURN OF THE HALL TO THE COMMUNITY**

Our committee is very thankful to all who played a role in upgrading the Yulunga Community Hall. The kitchen has been upgraded, a new storeroom has been added, acoustic tiles have been fitted to the ceiling, a new around system has replaced the old and, most importantly, we finally have the new toilets.

This means the mobile pre school can return to the hall once the Department of Education has approved the upgrades. I will be meeting with the pre school Director on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April to start that process. It may take a few weeks.

Yoga sessions will also return to the hall.

### **VOTING AVAILABLE LOCALLY ONCE MORE**

With the re-opening of our hall, we are pleased to let the community know that the hall has been registered as a voting centre for the forthcoming election.

### **SURFACE CLEANING OF THE TENNIS COURTS**

Our committee requested that council pressure clean the tennis courts as there has been a build up of mould on the surface that made the courts slippery during periods of wet weather.

The courts bring in a very good income (generally \$4,000 per annum) and have not been cleaned for many years, so council agreed to the request. We thank council for their quick response.

The courts are now looking in good condition for our Easter visitors.

### **A NEW EXTERNAL FIRE HOSE HAS BEEN INSTALLED**

State RFS has installed a new external fire hose to the rear of the hall, connected to an electric pump in the generator shed. The pump will be powered by the solar battery in case of a power outage during an emergency.

### **LANDSCAPING OF THE RESERVE CONTINUES**

Local volunteers continue to beautify the area in front of the Five Villages Community Garden and at the eastern end of the oval. We value our relationship with the community garden and are delighted with the beautification of this area of the reserve which was once just wasted space.
