Following the recent notification of the outcome of the Land and Environment Court case 2023/00263435 for the Inyadda Dr Manyana DA SF10921, members of the Red Head Villages Association (RHVA) seek further advice and clarification from Shoalhaven City Council. The RHVA is the CCB for the 5 villages of Manyana, Bendalong, Nth Bendalong, Cunjurong Pt and Berringer Lake.

At an RHVA general meeting on the 22nd November community members unanimously supported a resolution for RHVA executive representatives to meet with Council planners to seek answers to several questions which have been raised by our community. As you know the Red Head villages community has strongly and consistently opposed the Inyadda Dr Manyana development over several years. Areas of uncertainty remain for our community around the implications for the area of key aspects of the conciliated agreement.

We therefore request to meet with senior planning staff to discuss the community's ongoing questions. We request that this meeting is held at your earliest convenience as this remains a matter of high priority for our community.
